The cabinet has four pivoting central doors with a shelf, offering excellent storage. Constructed from pinewood without the need for nails or screws, it is decorated in traditional vibrant Tibetan colours. These cabinets were often used as family altars and would have also been seen in temples, where they were used to store religious scrolls, silk ceremonial clothes, and family valuables.
