A bold and impressive Mid Century cocktail ring. Chrysoberyl is a stunning stone, usually found in yellow, green, brown or blends of the three, and was particularly popular in the 1950s and 1960s. This ring features a large, oval shaped chrysoberyl in a rich, olive-y green with a slight yellow-ish secondary hue. The stone is rubover set in yellow gold and sits within a very heavy 18k yellow gold setting with distinctive vertical grooves. Accompanied by a Sapphire Report from The Gem & Pearl Laboratory confirming the chrysoberyl to be natural. Cut: Oval. Clarity: VS. Carat: The chrysoberyl is 4.61. Circa: 1960. Size: R (UK) or 8 5/8 (US). Free sizing available. Measurements: The chrysoberyl is approximately 11.5 x 7.5mm. The ring is 19mm across at the top of the ring and 11.8mm at the widest point. Sits 8.75mm from the finger. Weight: 12.90 grams. Metal: 18k gold. Tested.
