A Rosewood Wellington Chest. The substantial 19th century chest, with a rectangular top, finished with a cross banded facing and return chamfer, over the frieze with a flat facing lower mould edge. The body with six graduated drawers, each with a pair of button fronted turned knob handles. The drawers held within a hinged locking keep rail. The keep rails finished with folding leaf brackets. The Wellington Chest standing on a conforming plinth base. The whole in well figured rosewood, the drawers with solid mahogany linings and dust catchers. Complete with lock and key. Height 53 1/2 inches, 136cm. Width 25 inches, 63.5cm. Depth 19 1/4 inches, 49cm. Date circa 1850.
