In the center painted a delicate fantasy pattern with oriental motifs. The mark on the base has been worn down over time.

This beautiful Wedgwood bowl features a stunning dragon design from the Fairyland lustre collection. Crafted with the finest materials, this piece is sure to elevate any home decor. The brand's attention to detail and quality is evident in every aspect of this exquisite bowl. In 1909, Daisy Makeig-Jones was hired by the Wedgwood firm in Staffordshire, England, to decorate pottery. She would go on to develop the "Fairyland" luster pattern, which combined dazzling iridescent glazes with motifs from fairytales and would serve to revitalize the...

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
