A Beautiful Art Deco Silver and Pink Guilloche Enamelled Jewellery Box with a hinged lid and dark tan velvet interior. This jewellery box stands on three feet. Marked 'CSG & Co' for the maker 'Charles S Green & Co Ltd' and hallmarked Birmingham, 1926. *Guilloche enamel is a traditional decorative art form that combines intricate metalwork with vibrant enamel. It involves engraving a design onto a metal surface and filling the engraved lines with enamel, which is then fired to harden it in place. This technique is common in delicate works produced by Fabergé, particularly the famous Russian Fabergé eggs. Although expensive and time-consuming, guilloche enamelling produces beautiful effects, especially in depth of colour. Measurements: Height: 2 3/4" (approx. 7cm) Diameter: 5 1/4" (approx. 13.5cm) Total weight: 438g In good condition – any dark areas are shadows from the photography and there is no damage to the enamel.
