The bulbous bodies have a graduated reeded design at the top from which a pair of foliate scrolled handles connect to the rim. They are superbly decorated with neoclassical relief decoration of figures performing music and literature. They are raised on a pedestal base with a square plinth. This high quality hot cast solid bronze was produced using the traditional "lost wax" process, otherwise known as the "cire perdue" method. The craftsmanship is second to none throughout all aspects of this pair and they are sure to add an unparalleled touch of class to your home.
