 everyday objects. Dambourgez was known for his detailed and realistic still life paintings, often capturing
 everyday objects with great precision. His paintings often provide a glimpse into the daily life of the Parisian
 bourgeoisie at the end of the 19th century. According to the Revue des beaux-arts, his style in painting evolved
 from realism to naturalism, then became "frankly impressionist" from 1894 onwards. The painter left Paris in 1896
 to spend time in Spain, Italy and Morocco. He became a member of the Société des artistes Français from 1883.
