His art reflects the serene rural life of Surrey, Berkshire, Kent, and Sussex's southern counties, offering a stark contrast to the era's growing industrialization. While he was predominantly a watercolourist, Fox also produced oil paintings and extensive etchings that showcased the peaceful countryside, standing in contrast to the burgeoning industrialization of the 20th Century. He died in 1929 in Horsham, West Sussex. A versatile artist, Fox was celebrated for his picturesque views, rustic scenes, and landscapes. While he predominantly worked in watercolours, he also produced notable oil paintings, such as "Pony and Trap," a piece especially rare given his reputation as a waterco...
