## Description

This fine set of 12 dinner plates are made of Old Sheffield Plate. They date to c1800-1830 and bear no makers mark. They are marked for retailer R Rayman of New Bond Street in London. They are crested to the front for the Barnetts of Stratton Park near Biggleswade, Bedfordshire. Underneath the crest reads 'Nisi paret imperat' (Unless he obeys, he commands). Each plate is intialled for 'JJB' possibly for James Barnett (1760-1836). It is very rare to get such a large set of plates of this period. In good condition with no dents or splits but with slight signs of wear and faint surface scratching due to use. One plate has a stubborn black mark to the reverse. Total weight approx 6.4kg. Diameter approx 24.5cm
