Very small piece of onyx missing one Candelabra (see picture) Size Clock Piece: Height 70 cm, Width 43 cm and Depth 26.6 and Two Candelabra's : Height 70 cm, Width 18 cm and Depth 16 cm Sylvain Kinsburger was a French Sculptor who executed works in marble and bronze, and was also known as a medal engraver. He debuted at the Salon in 1878, with a number of bronzes. He became a member of the Société des Artistes Français. He won numerous awards several times over the years, receiving bronze medals at the Expositions Universelles of 1889 and 1900
