Description

A beautiful Art Deco sapphire and old cut diamond cluster ring. The sapphire in the centre - certified as natural, unheated and originating from Ceylon (Sri Lanka) - displays a bright, lapis blue. The stone is rubover set in platinum and 'floats' within a surround of twelve bright, white, and chunky old European cut diamonds in rubover platinum settings. Very pretty and intricate detailing in the gallery leads to a slim platinum shank. Accompanied by a sapphire report from Gemmological Certification Services (GCS) stating the sapphire shows no indication of heating, and is Sri Lankan (Ceylon) in origin. Cut: The sapphire is an oval cut, with old European cut diamonds. Colour: The diamonds are F to G. Clarity: The sapphire is loupe clean. The diamonds range from VS1 to SI1; all are clean to the naked eye. Carat: The sapphire is approximately 2.60 carat, with a total approximate diamond weight of 2.18 carat. Circa: 1925. Size: N 1/2 (UK) or 6.75 (US). Free sizing available. Measurements: The sapphire is approximately 10.3 x 8.2mm. The head of the ring is 20.4 x 17.4mm and sits 6.2mm from the finger. Weight: 5.73 grams. Metal: Platinum. French hallmarks....
