The figured mahogany base has a fielded panelled door and base, with bracket feet. The 14 inch beautifully painted dial has embossed brass hands , subsidiary seconds dial , date window , shell corner paintings and within the arch is a diorama of a rocking galleon that swings in time with the pendulum. It has an 8 day movement that strikes the hours on a bell. Height 225 cm / 88 " Width 52 cm / 20 " Depth 28 cm / 11 " In excellent condition, the case has been repolished, the movement has been fully serviced and is guaranteed for 12 months.
