This is an antique Japanese Satsuma plate made by Koshida factory from the Meiji period (1868-1912). The detailed craquelure glaze gives the plate a delicate, textured appearance, emphasizing its age and craftsmanship. This plate exemplifies the craftsmanship and attention to detail characteristic of Meiji era Satsuma Koshida ceramics, produced mainly for export. The plate is signed with Koshida character mark and Shimazu cross signifying the patronage of the powerful Shimazu family, who historically ruled the Satsuma area. Koshida is a well-known and a prolific Satsuma pottery maker that has been producing ceramics since the Meiji era (1868-1912). It is particularly renowned for its intricate designs, delicate color palette, and use of gold embellishments.
