Decorated with liver red enamel spots, feathered at the edges, yellow eyes, the dogs wear gilt collars and locketts. This particular pair of dogs are the unusual medium sized example of this fine model. Height – 19.5 cm, 7 3/4". Width – 16 cm, 6 1/4". Depth – 12 cm, 4 3/4". Condition – Minor wear to the gilding.
