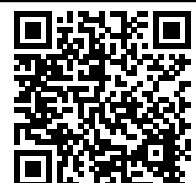
Description

English porcelain sauce tureen, cover and stand, c. 1820. The tureen hand painted in vibrant enamels with sprays of Spring flowers to either side, beneath a finely gilded intricate band of floral scroll. Having twin gilt branch handles, terminating in bunches of grapes. The cover similarly decorated, and surmounted with a branch handle. Having its original shaped oval stand, painted with a large spray of Spring flowers, within a gilt floral scroll border. Pattern number '162' to the bases. Width of tureen – 19.5 cm, 7 3/4". Height – 13 cm, 5 1/8". Depth – 11.7 cm, 4 5/8". Width of stand – 21 cm, 8 1/4". Condition – Minor wear to the overglaze enamels. No damage. No restoration.
