The Case The clock is in solid brass and stands 32cm high to the top of the dome 20cm wide on the gilded base with a depth of 15cm it is in perfect condition standing on a solid wooden base which is gilded and contained in the mint old blown glass dome, it is very heavy with thick heavy plates, a top quality old clock. The Dial The dial is in good original condition with black Roman numerals, the clock also retains its original black/blue steel ornate hands. The Movement The movement is an eight-day time only, the movement has been fully restored new spring was added and then serviced so keeping a great time over the eight days via the original pendulum and is a chain-driven fusee movement.
