London 1934 Art Deco period English hallmarked solid silver rectangular cut glass vanity or dressing table jar, made by Alexander Clark and Company. This jar has a heavy gauged engraved silver top, with gilt interior, and initials to centre, and a cut glass base. There is a small edge chip on corner at the top of one edge. Once used in travelling dressing table sets, this is now a perfect jar for dressing table or desk, to hold jewellery or other bits. The style makes it perfect for either a man or woman. Size-6.5 inches tall by 1.25 inches wide by 1 inch deep. Weight-135 grams total, 15 grams silver. In good condition.
