Description

This antique and rare hand-painted plate, produced by Beyer & Bock at the Volkstedt-Rudolstadt porcelain factory, exemplifies the high-quality craftsmanship typical of early 20th-century German porcelain.

The plate is richly decorated with gold ornaments on a purple background, reflecting the high standards of production. At its center is a scene by Swiss-Austrian artist Angelica Kauffman (1741-1807), known for her neoclassical paintings. The scene, featuring two women and a child, may symbolize an allegory of motherhood or family harmony, a recurring theme in Kauffman's work.
