Description

Antique Mahogany Double Fusee Mantel Clock By Budgen Croydon Engraved Movement. This lovely antique fusee mantel clock has a mahogany case with a rich colour and grain. The top of the case is arced with a small "pad" with a brass base as well as a round finial flanked by two brass spandrels. There is then a moulding to the top edge leading to the body of the case which has lion head handles and silk backed fretwork panels to the sides. The front corners then have lovely reeded columns with brass inlay and brass to both the top and the bottom. The front of the case is then inlaid beneath the dial. Finally the case has a moulding leading to the base which is finished by four round, brass feet. The dial is then painted and set out in black Roman numerals with a thin ring to the outside marking the minutes. The dial is then signed by the maker "BUDGEN Croydon" to the centre. The dial is then finished by two shaped hands as well as a protective glass set into a brass bezel (with working lock and key). The movement is then wound from the front and accessed from the back. It is a double fusee example of the upmost quality and works perfectly both ticking and chiming ...
