This magnificent tantalus features three wonderful hobnail cut square decanters with faceted ball stoppers and a mirrored back. The twin flap compartment in front revealing a delightful division with three cut crystal glasses and dominos. There is a secret compartment in the base, which springs open by pressing the secret button in front of the central decanter, revealing playing cards, cribbage board with score markers and dice. Complete with the original and working lock and key. It is a truly decorative piece which is also very practical and would make a lovely gift.
