Oil on canvas, a good 19th c. copy of the famous triple portrait by Van Dyck. The original, painted in 1635, was sent to Rome in order that the noted sculptor Bernini had an accurate image from which to sculpt a marble bust of the monarch. The painting now belongs to Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II. The bust was destroyed in the fire which severely damaged Whitehall Palace in 1698. Size: 40 x 50.5 inches inc 19th c oak frame.
