The genealogy map is printed upon paper and features a comprehensive detail of its history with both tartan examples showing the dress tartan and hunting tartan, along with its heraldic crest. A fine quality hand painted faux tortoiseshell, hand made frame of the period measures 153cm and 90cm wide, behind glass. The clan its society are still active. Whilst an excellent and rare example, the paper shows evidence of timeworn wear and some foxing to authenticate, mostly in very good condition with some distress to the bottom section, which perhaps got damp but remains intact, please see images.
