The pistols with browned octagonal damascus sighted barrels. Signed on the top flat "Lacy & Co of London" and also named to the lock plate "Lacy & Co". Engraved case-hardened patent breeches incorporating the back-sights, foliate engraved case-hardened tangs and locks, the latter signed and fitted with safety-catch. The hammer with dolphin top & decorated trigger guard. Varnished figured walnut three-quarter stocks, flattened chequered butts, steel & silver mounts, silver escutcheons and silver barrel-bolt escutcheons, both with ram rods. Nearly all in their original finish: in original lined and fitted oak case containing a brass shot flask, shot maker marked '34', double ended walnut screwdriver case, barrel cleaning tool and other tools. The lid with trade label of Lacy & Reynolds, 21, Great St. Helen's, Crosby Square, London. May not be the original label as the pistols signed Lacy & Co of London.
