The back is embossed with the Constellation line logo of the Geneva Observatory. This case variant is an example of the 'dog leg' case, with finely crafted lugs showing chamfers to the edge. Case reference 14902 62 SC. The watch has an original Omega winding crown. The watch is powered by a 24 jewel caliber 561 Omega mechanism.. The 19m serial numbers date this watch to 1962.
