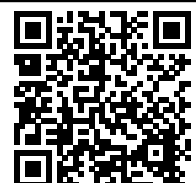
An unusual pair of early 19th century tripod tables. The circular dished tops of distinctly stripey grained timber (probably Gonzalo Alvis) with a baluster shaped and spiralled stem of the same distinctly grained wood on simple cabriole legs.
