A good example of an antique farmhouse chair dating from the late 19th century. It has a shaped elm seat with curved arms supported by turned spindles. It is high backed with lathe supports and it stands on ring turned legs joined by a H-stretcher. It has a wonderful patina and has mellowed to a nice warm colour. The rear of the seat is stamped with the maker's initials AH. It is in good original condition and is strong and sturdy. There are signs of age and use, some minor marks and knocks around the legs and some light surface marks on the seat but nothing detrimental. It has been gently cleaned and polished and is ready for use. The chair stands approximately 41 1/2" (105cm) high and 22" (56cm) wide across the arms. The seat is approximately 17" (43cm) high and 17" (43cm) deep. The best description comes from the photos so please look at them all carefully and if you have any questions just ask.
