Lovely quality and proportions, veneered to the back so can be free-standing in a room if required. *Taprell, Stephen & Holland (1803-1843) are recorded at St. James, Westminster, London. In 1843 they became Holland & Sons. The attribution is based on very similar but later tables bearing the Holland & Sons maker's stamp. Given the earlier date of this table it is likely to have been made by Taprell, Stephen & Holland. Good original, unrestored condition. Structurally sound. The top has some small surface dents and blemishes, see image * Source-Furniture History Society, British and Irish Furniture Makers Online ** Interestingly the renowned Scottish cabinet maker James Mein is recorded as using similar handles.
