The scene is set within a border of union wreaths, military weapons and the Crown and Mitre. It was from the BRITISH HISTORY SERIES made by JONES & SON, HANLEY, STAFFORDSHIRE POTTERIES, a pottery which only ran from 1826-28. The PLATE has a grand, old-fashioned rivet repair which shows the esteem in which the piece was held. It is quite stable.
