A mid sized telescope by Cary of London. William Cary (1759-1825) was a scientific instrument maker of considerable repute. He trained under Jesse Ramsden again a superb maker. This lovely instrument is beautifully made and in original condition signed on the last tube 'Cary London'. The main barrel is of mahogany with brass fittings and three tubes. It has excellent powerful lenses giving a clear image. The objective lens has its original (often lost) brass lens cap. The eye piece lens is protected by a brass shutter. It pulls out nicely and focusses easily. The later stand is of mahogany with the sockets lined with red baize. Measurements:- Length fully extended 77.5 cm Closed 25 cm About 5cm in diameter. The stand measures 43.5 cm long and 6 cm deep. Overseas buyers please ask for shipping costs before purchasing.
