The oval base with gilded inset mounts and standing on four turned and decorated feet. The decorative grid iron and paste set pendulum free swinging on the outer edge of the dial with spring suspension and unusual, for this type of clock, rise and fall mechanism. The convex enamel dial with Arabic numerals and floral decoration signed to the centre Howell and James, maker to the Queen, London and Paris, in excellent original condition. The fully restored twin train spring driven movement striking the hours and half hour on a bell, numbered 42. This beautiful quality clock is in excellent original condition with no damage to the marble and the original gilding to the mounts. A fine quality clock in excellent original condition...
