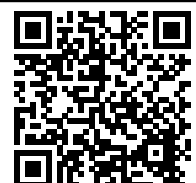
Description

This fine small sauce tureen is made of Old Sheffield Plate and has a silver handle, marked with a Thistle for Edinburgh and a young Victoria's head, dating the piece to c1840. Beautifully crested to the front with a Pegasus motif and standing on four bun feet. With shell motifs to the handles and edging. The condition is good overall with no dents or splits. The piece has a clean interior and the plating is in good order with only slight signs of age related wear. Some slight lifting to the lid. Weight approx 682g. Height approx 14.5cm. Total span approx 21cm. Depth approx 12cm
