Its intricate mechanism includes six-crossed train wheels, an anchor escapement, and a rack-strike with a trip repeat on a bell, ensuring reliable timekeeping and striking. Complete with a pendulum, winding key, mahogany veneered plinth, and protective glass dome, this timepiece offers a stunning display of traditional horology, ideal for collectors and enthusiasts alike.
