Such prestige and notability come as no surprise upon viewing this pair; evident by their fully silver gilt and magnificent design, this pair most definitely presents opulent and desirable characteristics of fine figural silverware. The pair is cast and sculpted in the form of a man and a woman, each meticulously detailed and decorated. The fact that two different figures/casting moulds would have been used for a single pair is a testament to its luxurious and 'no cost cut' stance, doubling the time and laborious craftsmanship to complete this pair.
