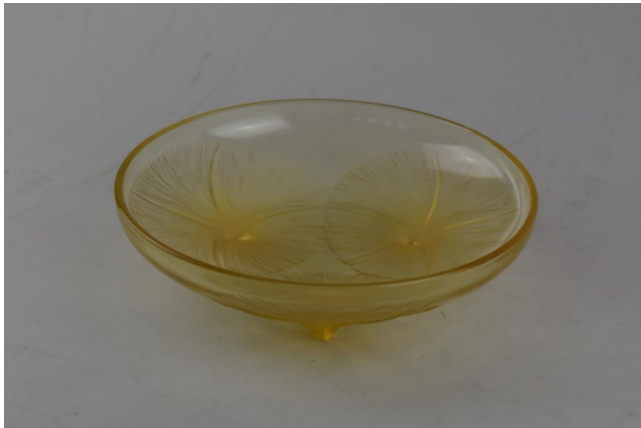

Rene Lalique Amber Volubilis bowl. A striking early 20th Century Art Deco French opalescent, clear and frosted amber glass shallow bowl. Decorated with Volubilis (Morning Glory) flowers the centre of which become the 3 feet of the bowl. Signed R Lalique France to the underside. Marcihac number 383. First designed 1921. A very attractive piece that would enhance any collection and shows the skill and quality of the master craftsman. History Rene Lalique 1880-1945 Rene Lalique was born a rural 19th century man in a pre-industrialized Europe. It was a time before light bulbs, and telephones, before automobiles and washing machines and electricity. But by the time of his death in 1945 at the dawn of the atomic age, he would have completed two careers spanning two different centuries. In 1900 at the age of 40, he was the most celebrated jeweller in the world and an art nouveau artist and designer of magnificent proportions. But by 1925 at the height of the art deco era he was the most celebrated glassmaker in the world. In between Lalique would leave his contemporaries behind as he turned from creating unique jewellery and objects d'art, to the mass production of innovat...
