The paintings delightfully present busy Venetian scenes of the Grand Canal, featuring gondolas and swans against a background of the Doges Palaces with a contrasting cloudy sky. The artist used very delicate pastel colours to add some mystery to the scenery with some vivid turquoise and slightly golden beige. Condition: In excellent gallery condition having been cleaned and relined by a local conservator in 2001.
