Description

This oil painting by Richard Geiger portrays one of his favoured themes. The piece depicts a Commedia Dell'arte female guitarist, a jester, and an attendant, with the signature present in the lower right corner. A red curtain and a textured wall serve as the backdrop, adding to the luxurious and theatrical atmosphere of the scene. The artwork is encased in a gilded frame, embellished with intricate designs at the corners. This exquisite painting, crafted by a renowned artist, will make a stunning centrepiece on any wall. Painting measures 58cm x 78.5cm. Richard Geiger (1870-1945), born in Vienna to a Hungarian Jewish family, began his studies at the Academy of Fine Arts Vienna, followed by the Academy of Arts in Berlin. He further honed his skills at the Académie Julian in Paris, concentrating on the Parisian lower class's life scenes. In 1896, Geiger made Budapest his home, where he excelled as a genre painter, illustrator, and graphic artist, frequently portraying carnival themes, portraits, nudes, and mythological scenes. He garnered multiple awards in graphic competitions and participated in exhibitions across France, Germany, and Hungary.

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
