When John baptised Jesus in the River Jordan he said 'Behold, the Lamb of God' (John 1: 36). ABOUT ARTIST MURILLO After Murillo's 16th century original oil painting " Titled The Infant Saint John the Baptist in the Wilderness ".An 18th Century depiction. Born in Seville in 1617, Murillo spent his entire career in the city, apart from at least one brief sojourn to the court of Madrid. He trained with Juan del Castillo, a prominent local painter, and went on to become an artist of considerable talent. When Seville was ravaged by a plague and famine in 1649-1651, many of the established painters including Zurbarán left the city. Murillo, however, stood his ground and continued to build his success with private...

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
