Description

This fine late Victorian silver bowl is a superbly crafted piece of silversmithing with its elegant and simple design it has a broad bowl raised onto a narrow stem with a moulded and stepped foot. It is externally decorated with beautifully chased raised and engraved garlands of flowers and foliage amongst shaped swags there is a panel front and back which could be inscribed if required. This heavy silver bowl retains traces of gilding on the interior showing its quality. This piece is hallmarked London 1897 -98 with the quality makers mark of Edward Barnard and Sons Ltd who were noted as major manufacturers of quality items at this period.
