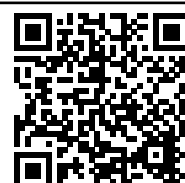

***** Mrs. Hudson, born Elizabeth Chilcot, was the daughter of a jeweler in Bath. Although no definite christening records can be found for her, it is assumed she was born around 1750. In 1776 her father referred to Elizabeth in an advertisement, where he said Hair work by Miss Chilcot, in all extensive forms, fancies & devices, likenesses, ciphers, urns, altars, trees, &c. Emblematic devices for mourning, love & Friendship, of rings, lockets, bracelets, buttons, snuffboxes, &c. Evidently she was not...

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
