BIOGRAPHY Robert Edward Morrison was the son of John Morrison, a joiner and later manager of one of the Peel timber yards. He moved to Liverpool in 1870 where he trained as a house painter and served part of his apprenticeship with William Nicholson of Douglas, father of the Manx artist, John Miller Nicholson. Aged. 21 he became a student at the Liverpool School of Art, and studied under John Finnie. He later studied in Paris at the Académie Julian under Bouguereau and Tony Fleury. The artist started exhibiting at the Royal Academy in 1884. He also exhibited extensively at the Liverpool Academy, acting as its President from 1895 to 1905. He was an a...

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
