The set features a young boy and girl standing beside tree stumps that serve as the candleholders. Each figure is intricately detailed, from the gilded buttons on the boy's clothes to the floral buckles on the girl's shoes. These candlesticks were likely both decorative and functional, embodying the era's fascination with elaborate candle lighting. Each piece bears the Royal Worcester mark on the base and is signed by Hadley on the side, enhancing their appeal and value to collectors. The Worcester porcelain factory, established in 1751, is one of the oldest porcelain manufacturers in England, renowned for its exceptional craftsmanship and innovation. By the 1870s, operating under the name Worcester Royal Porcelain Company, the factory had expanded its repertoire to include ornate decorative pieces such as figurines and candleholders, alongside its functional wares.
