Hexagonal moulding is rare on a bonnet glass, the vast majority being diamond or honeycomb moulded. **Date & Origin** England, c1780. Period of George III. **Condition** Excellent, no chips cracks or restoration **Dimensions** Height: 7.2cm Rim diameter: 6.2cm Foot diameter: 5.3cm. **Historical Relevance** Hand-blown around the time King Louis XV disbanded French parliament on the 9th of May 1753.
