Technical Description An 18th-century bonnet glass with an ogee bowl. A rudimentary stem with a conical foot and snapped pontil. A fine example. Bonnet glasses come with a surprising variation in moulding, however, finding a plain bowl example is very difficult and we would say that this is probably the first example we have had. **Date & Origin** England, c1780. Period of George III. **Condition** Excellent, no chips cracks or restoration. **Dimensions** Height: 7.1cm Rim diameter: 6.1cm Foot diameter: 5.4cm. **Historical Relevance** Hand-blown around the time King Louis XV disbanded French parliament on the 9th of May 1753.

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
