A cast brass bezel with bevelled glass and a silvered inner ring. A superb, chronometer fusee mechanism with maintaining power, of 8-day duration. Circa 1865. Width 7 1/2" / 18.5cms Depth 3 1/2" / 9cm. Klaftenberger of London were fine makers. Prince Albert & Queen Victoria purchased clocks and watches from them.
