Fitted with the original interior of green baize and complete with dividers and a holding strap. Inside are two turned wood and brass rods and brushes used for cleaning purposes. The lid is fitted with its original brass spring catch and it comes with a working key (appears original). Two reinforcement straps are fitted to the outside of the case. Founded in 1835 and with two royal warrants Holland & Holland are one of the world's best rifle and shotgun manufacturers.
