Description

A breathtaking antique sapphire ring. The oval shaped sapphire - certified as natural, unheated and originating from Ceylon (Sri Lanka) - displays a rich and deep blue. The stone is rubover set in 18k yellow gold and surrounded by 19 old mine cut diamonds set in silver, which sits atop a slender tapering shank which displays a very slightly blush coloured gold. Accompanied by a sapphire report from The Gem & Pearl Laboratory stating the sapphire shows no evidence of heating, and is Sri Lankan (Ceylon) in origin. Cut: Oval shaped step-cut sapphire and old mine cut diamonds. Colour: The diamonds range from H to I. Clarity: The sapphire is eye clean. The diamonds range from SI1 to SI2. Carat: The sapphire is 2.00 carat. The total approximate diamond weight is 0.57 carat. Circa: 1915. Size: I (i) 1/2 (UK) or 4 1/2 (US). Free sizing available. Measurements: The sapphire is 9.3 x 8mm. The head of the ring is 14.8 x 12.5mm and sits 5.4mm from the finger. Weight: 3.80 grams. Metal: The band and the finger bezel are 14k gold (which has a very slight rose tint). The diamonds are set in silver and the sapphire is in 18k yellow gold. Tested with a Niton DXL...

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
