## Description

A Victorian ruby and diamond ring of true quality. The glowingly bright red ruby - certified as natural, unheated and originating from Burma (Myanmar) - is claw set in yellow gold and sits at the heart of an elegant navette shaped cluster set with 16 old mine cut diamonds. Sits nice and snug to the finger on a slim, 18k yellow gold wire shank. Accompanied by a ruby report from The Gem & Pearl Laboratory stating the ruby shows no evidence of heating, and is Burmese (Myanmar) in origin. Cut: Cushion cut ruby and old mine cut diamonds. Colour: The diamonds range from G to H. Clarity: The ruby is slightly included but clean to the naked eye. The diamonds range from VS2 to SI2 and are clean to the naked eye. Carat: The ruby 0.84 carat, with a total approximate diamond weight of 0.72 carat. Circa: 1890. Size: Q 1/2 (UK) or 8.25 (US). Free sizing available. Measurements: The ruby is 5.9 x 4.6mm. The head of the ring is 20.9 x 8.9mm and sits 5.75mm from the finger. Weight: 3.92 grams. Metal: 18k gold. Tested with a Niton DXL Precious Metal Analyzer.
