Technical Description A very fine 18th-century Light Baluster wine glass dating to c1745. It has a large round funnel bowl engraved with two hands reaching out of the clouds, holding a thorny wreath, one hand pointing at the other. The clouds are flanked by olive branches, the branches tied in a knot at the base. Finally the words "PLUTOT MOURIR QUE MANQUER DE FOY" (I would Rather Die than Show Lack of Faith) are engraved within a long streaming flag or banderole. A fine stem reflecting the message of the glass with small baluster and inverted baluster knops. Conical foot. **Date & Origin** England, c1745. Period of George II. **Condition** Excellent, age-related wear as shown. No chips, cracks or restoration. **Dimensions** Height: 17.2cm Rim diameter: 7.5cm Foot diameter: 8cm
