A Very Good Quality Early 19th Century, Regency Period, Mahogany Miniature Chest, Having Well Figured Rectangular Top Over Three Long Drawers, With Replacement Brass Turned Knobs, Flanked By Elegant Half Turned Outstanding Columns To Each Side, Raised On Elegant Original Turned Feet. A great example of an 18th century regency miniature chest of drawers. A relatively plain rectangular design is enhanced greatly by the use of rich mahogany timbers and elegant carved columns. The proportions are also interesting as a full size counterpart would be highly regarded due to the low height versus wide width ratio. The brass turned knobs are replaced, but sit well on the piece and also it stands on its original turned feet which are very elegant. Almost certainly this was made as a travelling salesmans sample piece of furniture originally. There is regular debate over whether miniature furniture was made as an apprentice piece, which is when a craftsmen who was looking for a job at a workshop would create something to showcase their talents.
