All bears the manufacturer's name and Royal Warrant of "Gieves Ltd, 21, Old Bond St., London, By Special Appointment to His Majesty the King". The tole-ware box has a locking hasp and carrying handle, bears the name of the officer 'H.R.B Janvrin R.N' and has an embossed shield name-plate for "Gieves Limited".
